WAR & OCCUPATION

Canada in the Era of War and Occupation

Since the US/UK invasion of Iraq on March 20, 2003, people around the world, especially in the third world, have come under attack in an era of intensifying war and occupation. Today, three years later, Iraq remains under occupation, with more than 140,000 occupation troops on the ground. And four years later, Afghanistan remains devastated, both countries with hundreds of thousands of people dead and disabled.

The government of Canada has in the last year alone deployed more than 2000 soldiers to Afghanistan, where it now leads the occupation forces over Southern Afghanistan and Kandahar. In the interest of shifting away from its "traditional middle power" status to become a "key player on the world stage", Canada has doubled the military budget to 25 billion dollars.

In 2004, the US, Canada and France led the invasion and occupation of Haiti, overthrowing the democratically elected government of President Aristide and murdering thousands of innocent Haitians.

And Zionist Israel has continued in the brutal occupation of Palestine, killing and robbing Palestinians while forcibly removing them from their own land. Here in Canada, Indigenous peoples, by the same forces of colonization, have their territories and resoures continue to be stolen, and the living conditions for their communities worsen.

Today, imperialist governments are elevating threats against Iran, Syria, Venezuela and Cuba.

The goal of the MAWO conference is to open up in-depth analysis, dialogue, and debate on the imperialist initiatives in the occupations of Iraq, Afghanistan, Palestine, Haiti, and Indigenous Nations in Canada, and in the threats of intervention in Iran, Cuba, and Africa. In addition, MAWO's goal is to critically examine our program thus far in confronting imperialism and building an effective anti-war movement.
